




ABOUT THE DATA

These data should be interpreted with caution as there are gaps and limitations in the dataset. Data are based on estimated count; some data were suppressed and not included to protect student privacy. Numbers and percentages have been rounded to the nearest whole number. Data Source: VDOE PALS-K 2012–2016, pulled January 2018.

For 2012–2016, Powhatan reported very small numbers of non-white students. To preserve student anonymity, data for student subgroups of fewer than 10 (n = <10) are not reported. School districts have access to this data and are encouraged to examine it if they are interested in a more detailed exploration of achievement gaps.
